All exhibitors are eligible to be awarded a cup, however for an exhibitor to leave the showground with a cup, they need to be a paid-up member of The Norwich & District Goat Club.

Cup winers will be asked to return the awarded cup/s in the 1<sup>st</sup> instance to the NDGC Christmas Social or at the very latest to the NDGC AGM held in February.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that awarded cups are returned, cleaned, in good overall condition and have been labelled as awarded.

Failure to return cups when requested or return cups in poor condition will result in the exhibitor being prohibited from being allowed to leave future shows with awarded cups.

Exhibitors will be requested to sign the cups form upon receipt of a cup.

# Requirements set out by The Norwich and District Goat Club (NDGC) and The Wayland Agricultural Society

All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted at least 30 days prior to the date of the show (4<sup>th</sup> July 2024).

No pregnant goat may enter the showground. In the event of an unforeseen kidding or abortion taking place, the goat must immediately be isolated from other goats. Full details of goat exhibitor and action taken must be reported in writing by the Chief Steward to the NDGC Secretary immediately after the show.

Kids must be a minimum of 2 months old on day of show (4<sup>th</sup> June 2024)

The eartag number of any goat entered must be submitted to the show secretary before the goat competes in the show.

Earmarks will be checked – all goats need to be double tagged or have one eartag and one pastern tag fitted. Goats with only one tag will not be permitted to enter.

Attached Declaration form must be completed and returned with entries.

#### <u>C.A.E.</u>

#### A copy of the current C.A.E whole herd certificate must accompany your entry

All goats must have a valid C.A.E test certificate and must have tested negative within the last 12 months prior to the show. The certificate must show the earmark of the goat. Please note kids must have proof of being from a negative tested dam. Exhibitors are asked not to bring to the show any goat that has EVER had a positive reaction to a C.A.E test. Monitored herds will be penned separately.

#### **Booking in on the day**

# Arrival will be the livestock exhibitors' entrance via Brandon Road, Watton and all animals must be penned by 8:30AM

(Exhibitors arriving late maybe refused entry & no refund given)

Upon arrival, please make contact with the Chief Steward or Show secretary, all goats MUST be penned in the pens allocated and vehicles moved to the designated exhibitor parking – no vehicle movements are allowed whilst the show is in progress, animals can leave the showground 5pm onwards.

Exhibitors MUST bring a completed Animal Movement Licence and a second semi-completed for the return journey. Please hand these in to the secretary, homeward bound licences will be issued before departure.

Please contact Zoe Mitchell for blank movement licences.

The Show Committee and judge has the right to divide or cancel any class, its decision in this or any other matter is final.

If the show has to be cancelled prior to its commencement, for reasons outside our control, all competitive entries will be refunded for the full amount paid.
